The TTU Library (Volpe Library) houses approximately 347,146 books, 136,009 bound periodical volumes, 177,791 volumes of Government publications and 1,495,788 pieces of various types of microforms. As a member of the Southeastern Library Network (SOLINET), TTU library can access the nation's largest bibliographic network to acquire unavailable material through inter-library loans. In this seminar, Regina Lee of the Government Publications, TTU library will provide a broad overview of the resources available for CEE graduate students to conduct research (such as literature search or request unavailable material). CEE seniors, fast-track students and new graduate students are particularly encouraged to attend. Hands-on demonstration of TTU's online resources will be demonstrated for students.
